- ❖ 12 stones were retrieved from the bottom of the River Jordan and placed on dry land as a memorial to God’s miraculous parting of the river as the Israelites crossed its water.
-Joshua 4:20-24-
- ❖ The prophet Samuel set up the Ebenezer stone (“Stone of Help”) as a permanent reminder of the Lord’s aid in defeating the Philistines.
-1Samuel 7:12-
- ❖ Jacob anointed the stone he used as a pillow, set it up as a pillar and called the place Bethel or “House of God” because the Lord had promised to always watch over, and be with him.
-Genesis 28:18-22-
