Pastoral Team Member for Children's Ministry (CM)

Key Responsibilities:

- Assist the Pastor-In-Charge and CM Co-ordinator oversee the operation of CM according to the church's strategic directions
- Provide pastoral leadership, care, nurture and inspire congregation members to be passionate in serving the children and develop them to be God-fearing young men and women
- Procure, develop and prepare bible study curricula for the ministry
- Conduct training for new helpers
- Work with CM Co-ordinator to disciple helpers (teaching and non-teaching)
- Work with helpers to gather and follow-up with children in the church
- Equip helpers to counsel and coach children in their faith journey

REFLECTION & DISCUSSION QUESTIONS



EXODUS 33:7-23

"GOD REVEALS HIS GLORY"

These questions have two purposes:

- (i) One is to enable everyone to reflect on what the Bible passage is saying, what the passage or a specific part of it means, and what it is saying to us and challenging us to be or to act.
- (ii) The other is for members of cell groups to share with their cell group how God is challenging them and how they intend to respond to Him.

Context:

When Moses went up the mountain to receive the Law from God, his people became impatient and worshipped a golden calf. The passage looks at Moses response to their sin, and what it says about his relationship with God.

Observation Questions:

What is one observation you have made from this passage about Moses' relationship with God and with His people?
How did those relationships affect how he acted?

Interpretation Questions:

What was Moses asking of God, "show me your glory" (18)?
Why do you think human beings cannot see God and live (21-23)?
How are things different after the coming of Jesus Christ?

Transformation Question:

How did God reveal Himself to Moses? Would you like God to reveal Himself to you? Have your experienced God's fullness and love? How should that change the way you live your life?
