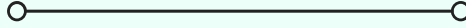

REFLECTION & DISCUSSION QUESTIONS



MARK 1:1-15

"BAPTISM OF THE LORD"

These questions have two purposes:

- (i) One is to enable everyone to reflect on what the Bible passage is saying, what the passage or a specific part of it means, and what it is saying to us and challenging us to be or to act.
- (ii) The other is for members of cell groups to share with their cell group how God is challenging them and how they intend to respond to Him.

1) Of the various characters mentioned in this passage (e.g. John the Baptist, the people of Jerusalem, Jesus, etc) share about a character trait they display and why you admire it.

2) Why do you think it is significant that Jesus was baptised by John?

3) God the Father proclaims of Jesus, "You are my Son, whom I love; with you I am well pleased." This same affection is also given to you and I (Jn 3:16, 1 Jn 3:1). Share about a time when God's love was particularly comforting to you.

Transformation Questions:

4) In this passage, Jesus begins His ministry with a call to "repent and believe the good news!" Repentance asks us to joyfully embrace the hope and change offered to us. What habit, activity or sin do you need to welcome God's power to radically change?
